

Hepatitis C is transmitted by:

- Blood and blood product transfusions
- Needlestick accidents among healthcare workers
- Illicit injection drug use
- Other blood-to-blood contact
 - Acupuncture
 - Tattooing
 - Sharing certain personal care items (e.g. razors, toothbrushes, nail clippers, or nail files)
 - Healthcare workers' or other professionals' occupational accidents
 - Transmission from a mother to her unborn child
 - Transmission during hemodialysis treatment
 - Blood-to-blood contact during sexual activity
 - Intranasal cocaine use through the sharing of straws or other instruments
